CLIFTON'S STORY

Clifton has lived in the Colorado foothills his entire life. A widower, he has a small ranch with large dogs, horses and goats and loves not living in town.

About 10 years ago, Clifton started experiencing significant vision problems that ultimately lead to inoperable cataracts. He was having a difficult time with small details of independent living—like seeing the dials on the stove. When he started having hearing loss as well, Clifton began to fear that he would not be able to remain in his home.

While his neighbor helped with his animals, Clifton was having trouble addressing his own nutrition. Because of his inability to see the stove, his meals mostly consisted of cereal and sandwiches.

Clifton's son would come down

from Estes Park on the weekends to support his father, but he was diagnosed with COVID-19 in September. Fortunately, his son suggested Clifton call Meals on Wheels.

Clifton was delighted to discover that Meals on Wheels of Loveland and Berthoud delivers to Masonville because he thought he would be out of the delivery area. He now receives seven meals each Tuesday that he is able to use throughout the week.

Since then, Clifton has stopped losing weight, he feels stronger and is less anxious about having to leave the mountains. Instead, he is able to remain living on the ranch that is so dear to him.

Clifton is just one of hundreds of local residents who are able to stay in their homes independently thanks to the services provided by Meals on Wheels.

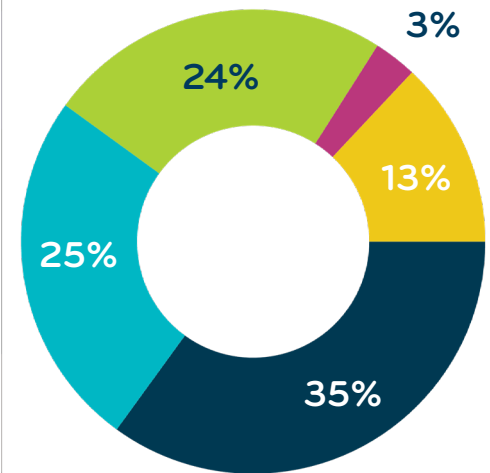

REVENUE: \$979,018*

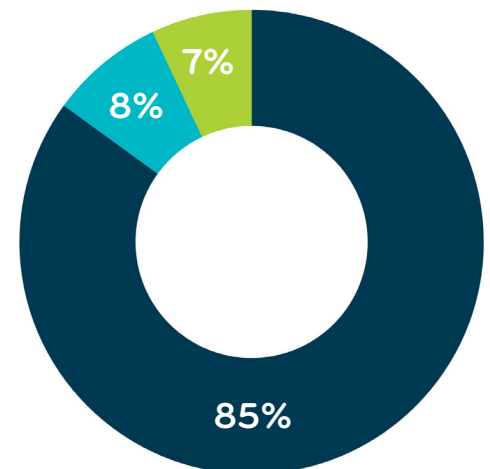
